<p><u>Staffing:</u> We have had two resignations, one in Title 1 and the other in our Future Leaders Program. Advertisements have gone out on School Spring.</p> <p><u>Professional Development, School Wide</u></p> <p><u>Goals, and Curriculum:</u> The staff continues to work on fully implementing PBIS. We recently held our first school-wide assembly, and were pleased to accept a check from Walmart for \$1,700. Elm Street School was selected to receive the money raised when delivery drivers were able, in the month of July, to drive over 1700 miles without an accident.</p> <p>Staff has worked on streamlining the behavior reporting system and developing a common understanding at grade levels about major and minor incidents.
