Similar to previous years, half of our Winter/Spring course catalog will include pages from the larger district and is scheduled to be in mailboxes during the first week of January. In addition to high school completion, college preparatory and computer classes, we are in the process of scheduling approximately thirty community enrichment classes to be offered from January through May. These range from fitness and outdoor recreation to hobby, technical and informational content. With the cancellation of nearly a dozen enrichment classes this Fall due to low enrollment, we are hoping to experience an uptick in participation next semester!

Academic Enrollments

We had eight new students start in the month of November, bringing our enrollment to a total of 31 students in academic, career and computer classes since July 1. The recent enrollments included six High School Completion students, one College Preparatory student and one English Language Learner.
